Statement of Work

Contractor Performance Requirements:

News and Feature Reports from Reporters in Cuba

The contractor shall serve as a staffing agency for OCB's network of reporters inside Cuba. Contractor shall provide stories and special assignments produced by journalists in Cuba to the Broadcasting Board of Governors (BBG) Office of Cuba Broadcasting (OCB) to include: (1) video packages – two to five minutes in length, (2) raw footage (B-roll, interviews, sound bites), (3) written stories (news or feature stories), or (4) audio interviews suitable for radio broadcast. There are no minimum required stories to be submitted during the term of the contract. A submitted story must be accepted and used by OCB Central News to be considered an assignment payable by OCB. Stories can be voluntarily submitted by the contractor. Acceptance of stories and special assignments will be based on the professional judgment of individuals within the agency. These stories must meet the OCB Central News Editorial Guidelines (available upon request). OCB may work directly with the reporters during the editing process and may not necessarily route all edits and revisions to reports back to the contractor.

Payments to Reporters

The contractor must have the ability to act as a third party payee for OCB's designated reporters inside Cuba and make payments to those journalists. Payments to the reporters must be made no later than three days after contractor receives payment from the BBG. Note that the BBG has a license from the Department of Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control to engage the services of Cuban nationals in Cuba for the purpose of preparing news-related broadcasting materials for rebroadcast by the BBG.

Usage Rights:

Contractor will assign all copyright to any and all artistic works created and accepted by OCB under this Contract to the Broadcasting Board of Governors.

Submission of Invoices:

The contractor shall submit a proper invoice in accordance with FAR 52.232#25 Prompt payment (Oct 2003). The Contractor shall submit invoices that properly reflect the work performed and accepted by the Government. Submission of an invoice that does not accurately reflect or otherwise misrepresents the work performed may be considered fraud subjecting the Contractor to immediate "Termination for Cause."

Term of Contract:

The term of this contract is from **July 8, 2013 through October 31, 2013.**
